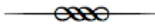
Speakers & Topics

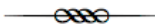

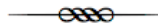


Ong Eu Jin has been on both sides of the line between corporate management and the legal adviser.

He will speak on **Management's View of Legal Issues** and how legal counsel and practitioner can add real world value to the business organisation.

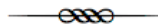

He will talk about the development of the law with regard to **Directors' Duties to Creditors**.

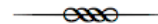


Adlin Abdul Majid spent several years as in-house counsel with a government agency involved in the implementation of the Multimedia Super Corridor initiative.
